

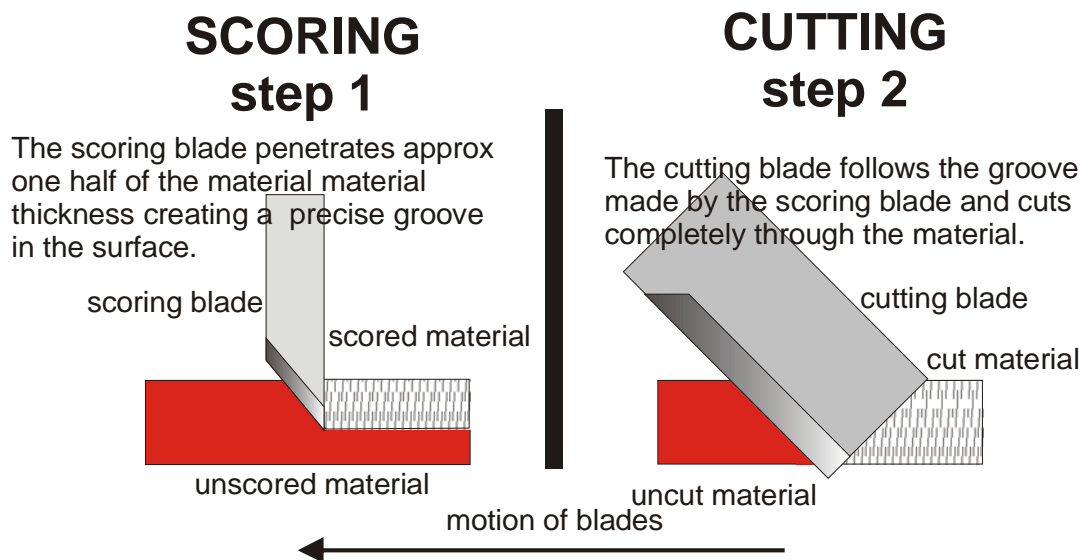
USING THE OPTIONAL SCORING HEAD

You have purchased a Han-D-Cut cutter, one of the most versatile and precise cutters available. You can purchase an optional scoring head at www.hdcut.net.

Using the scoring head in conjunction with the standard cutter head allows you to cut more materials, easier and more accurately. The scoring head creates a partial cut thru tuff materials such as (expanded pvc, sintra, Komatex, coroplast, etc.).

Use the scoring head by itself, to cut tuff thin materials, such as polycarb, mylar, polystyrene, etc.

Using the scoring head before using the cutting head will greatly reduce the amount of force required to make the cut.



INSTRUCTIONS FOR USE OF THE SCORING HEAD.

1. Position and clamp the material to be cut using the spring clamp.
(It is very important that the material is not moved between the scoring and cutting steps.)
2. Place the scoring head on the beam and make 1 or 2 passes. **PRESS DOWN LIGHTLY ON THE KNOB WITH THE PALM OF YOUR HAND.** You do not need to press down hard. The scoring blade is very sharp and will easily cut into the material.
3. Remove the scoring head and proceed to finish the cut with the cutting head.
